4D, 5D and 6D LASER FACELIFT

OUTLINE:

As we become older our skin becomes thinner and dryer as the result of loss of collagen and elastin fibers - and the hyaluronic acid which is responsible for our skins firmness and hydration. This and loss of fat from the face and bone result in the appearance of wrinkles, deepening of nasolabial folds, crepey skin, sagging and a tired look.


The patented FOTONA 4D LASER FACELIFT® consists of four different laser modes at each treatment session to tighten, brighten and lift the skin in four steps.

Step 1- SMOOTH tightening around the vaginal opening

Step 2 - FRAC3® Skin rejuvenation

Step 3 - PIANO® Skin tightening

Step 4 – Superficial® light peel



5 D Laser Facelift consists of all four steps plus SmoothEye® eyelid tightening and lift

6 D Laser Facelift consists of steps 1,2,3,4,5 plus SmoothNose - non-surgical laser rhinoplasty and 3D neck skin tightening and rejuvenation

INDICATIONS:

1. Younger individuals in their 30s for prevention of skin ageing.
2. Older individuals in their 40's, 50s, 60s and 70's for treatment of signs of skin ageing like laxity, lines and wrinkles, pigmentation, broken veins and skin sagging to achieve fresher, brighter, smoother and firmer complexion.

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

Pregnancy, infections, active herpes infection, within one week of chemical peel, within 6 months of Roaccutane, within 2 weeks of topical retinol, during an active autoimmune condition, inflammatory skin condition, allergy to lidocaine.

PATCH TEST

This treatment requires a patch test to be performed 3 days before treatment

SKIN ANALYSIS

Prior to treatment you will need to have consultation with our dermatologist or an aesthetic therapist to assess your suitability for treatment and specialist skin care recommendation.

SKIN PREPARATION

Skin preparation before the procedure includes replenishing moisture, suppression of pigment production in the skin and broad-spectrum sunscreen with SPF 30+ used for at least 2 weeks before. This will prepare the skin for laser treatment and assure uncomplicated recovery.

ANAESTHESIA

Anesthesia is not generally required. Topical anesthetic cream can be applied on the lips and eyelids to minimize discomfort 1 hour before laser treatment. Very cold air will be added if necessary, during step 2 and 3 if necessary. Ice packs will be used to cool down the skin after the procedure.

PROCEDURE:

The skin is cleansed with suitable antiseptic and moisturized prior to the procedure. You will be wearing specialist goggles to protect your eyes. Laser beam will be passed over the treated area several times to reach adequate temperature in the treated tissue. Your skin's temperature will be monitored regularly. The sensation you will experience resembles the warmth you experience during sunbathing.

Step 1: Intra-oral SMOOTH® mode. The erbium laser "SMOOTH® mode" produces non-ablative, gentle, controlled heating of the tissue inside the mouth. The Fotona erbium 4D, 5SMOOTH® mode has been used in dentistry for many years to treat gum disease. It results in firming and tightening of the lower face by shrinking existing collagen fibers and stimulation of new collagen production in the treated tissue. This gives visible lifting effect and removal of fine lines around the lips and lips plumping effect.

Step 2: Pre-heating of the skin using Nd:YAG FRAC3®. This patented non-ablative laser mode gently but rapidly heats up the skin in a fractionated pattern to gently tighten up the skin and remove skin imperfections like fine lines, pigmentation, open pores, under the skin. It improves skin texture, closes open pores, reduces oiliness, irons out fine lines, reduces pigmentation and gives instant mild tightening effect.

Step 3: Bulk heating with Nd:YAG PIANO® mode. The PIANO mode delivers heat slowly to the deeper layers of the skin resulting in more tightening effect and stimulation of new collagen production in the skin giving firmer and more lifted complexion. This improves with the number of treatments over time and continues after the course of treatment was finished.

Step 4: Erbium Superficial® mode is a gentle superficial laser peel to remove surface imperfections like uneven skin tone and texture. Small, benign skin blemishes can be removed at the same time. The strength of the peel can be chosen according to the client's desires for an improvement and downtime and may range between ultra-superficial, superficial, medium to deep, full spot, fractional, hot or cold.

Step 5: Nd:YAG VERSA® mode. This mode is done with added cooling for maximum comfort and treats vascular skin abnormalities such as dilated facial blood vessels (telangiectasia), spider veins, is used to angiomas and hemangiomas. In addition, VERSA mode is used to treat skin breakouts in acne or rosacea. Result is breakout, redness and telangiectasia free skin.

Step 6: SMOOTHEye® or Laser Rhinoplasty (nose job). In this step a non-ablative erbium SMOOTH® mode is used to tighten up and rejuvenate delicate skin of the eyelids or lift and shorten the tip of nose by gently but effectively heating up treated skin and cartilage.

TIME 60 to 90 minutes per treatment session

WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER TREATMENT?

Immediately after treatment your skin will be red and hot. You may experience mild burning sensation which is normal. The burning sensation usually stops after 12 hours and the skin looks pink like after sunbathing. Skin feels tighter and dry. Gently peeling starts after 4 days and is usually completed within 7 days. Breathing through the nose may be slightly impaired temporarily due to mild swelling of the nasal mucosa after laser rhinoplasty.

COMPLICATIONS:

Complications after laser facelift are uncommon. Rarely areas of redness and tenderness may take over a week to resolve. Post-inflammatory hyperpigmentation (PIH) occasionally develops in darker skin tones and fades away with time. It can be prevented by skin preparation before laser treatment and the use of whitening products after treatment. Skin may become very dry. This gets better with regular use of moisturizers which should be reapplied during the day.

DOWNTIME:

Laser facelift procedure There is no recovery time and the treatment can be done all year round even if the skin has a lead to minimal or no downtime. It is advisable to avoid strenuous physical activity or sauna for 24 hours post procedure. Make up can be work the following day. Skin peeling phase ranges between 3 days in the case of cold, superficial peel to 7 days in medium, cold peel to 21 days in deep, hot laser peel.

AFTERCARE:

You will receive complementary LPL LED using blue, red and infrared light for their healing and antibacterial properties. You will also get Post Procedure Kit consisting of a cleanser, recovery balm and mineral sunscreen with SPF 40 + to use after the procedure for a few days. Regular skin care and pigment production suppressants may have to be used by individual with darker skin tone or pigmentation problem. It is recommended to moisturize skin regularly and protect it from sun exposure by using broad spectrum sunscreen with SPF 30+ which should be reapplied regularly. Breathable foundation like Oxygenetics with SPF 30+ can be used the following day.

NUMBER OF TREATMENTS:

Between 3 to 6 treatments every 4 to 6 weeks apart. The number of treatments depends on the severity of skin damage. It is customary to have 1 treatment per decade of life e.g. 30s - 3 treatments, 40s – 4 treatment, 50s – 5 treatments, 60s – 6 treatments

MAINTENANCE:

Maintenance treatment every 6 to 12 months is recommended
